DATE: January 19, 201 DEADLINE: **December 7, 2018**

- 1 An ensemble consists of two or more performers playing collaborative music. *Instrumental solos with piano accompaniment and concerti movements are not allowed.* Limit your entries to duets, duos, trios, quartets, etc.
- 2 Ensembles must be entered in the age category of the oldest member. For example, a 6<sup>th</sup> grade student playing with a 5<sup>th</sup> grade student would need to enter the Middle School category. Elementary School is grades K-5, Middle School is grades 6-8, and High School is grades 9-12.
- 3 Any ensemble with a post-high school age member must enter the Non-Competitive category. Teachers and parents are allowed to perform with students but must enter the Non-Competitive category.
- 4 Competitive Categories will be in a master class format. The adjudicator will work with each team individually. No written comments will be given. The non-competitive category will be a recital only format with general adjudicator comments given to all participants at the end (no individual comments).
- 5 All ensemble repertoire is permitted, original form, arrangements, transcriptions, classical, popular, jazz, etc. An original copy of the score must be provided for the adjudicator in competitive categories only. *No photocopies will be allowed.*
- 6 Abide by the time limits, cuts in scores are permitted.
- 7 Enter one ensemble team per entry form
- 8 Make your check payable to OMTA-Portland District.
